Under this agreement for 2017
Thuringowa State High School will receive

\$374,565*

This funding will be used to

- increase school attendance from 79.1% in 2016 to 85% in 2018
- increase the % of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English from 51% Year 6 (2015) to 75% in Year 8 (2017)
- increase the % of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English from 62% Year 7 (2015) to 80% in Year 9 (2017)
- Increase the % of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English from 58% Year 6 (2016) to 75% in Year 8 (2018)
- achieve senior certification (Queensland Certificate of Education or Queensland Certificate of Individual Attainment) of at least 95% in 2017

Our initiatives include

- provide professional development, coaching and resources to build teacher capability in explicit instruction, gradual release of responsibility, reading, writing and numeracy strategies, indigenous education, differentiation and student behaviour management
- improve case management and support for all students
- strengthen student and parental engagement in attendance and learning processes
- further develop the leadership team as a collaborative learning team

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- employing additional teacher and teacher aide fractions for co-teaching, additional classroom support, case management, student behaviour management, inclusive practices and priority areas
- allocate TRS to facilitate teacher capability development
- implementing professional development and resources to build leadership and teacher capacity in priority areas
